NOMINATIONS

Since 1955, the Board of Directors of AIA Chicago has recognized individuals and organizations who have given outstanding service to the Chicago architectural community as a whole, including service to the profession, public service, and education. This award is not necessarily presented every year. Individuals, associations, AIA Chicago members, and members of the Chicago community at large are eligible for this award. Past honorees have included architects, craftspersons, educators, authors, journalists, and organizations of various types. Nominations may be made by any AIA Chicago member or by the AIA Chicago Board of Directors itself.

Candidate information should include:

- biographical or historical information
- descriptions and illustrations of significant projects
- list of awards, honors, or other recognition received by the individual or organization
- published materials written about the individual or organization; published materials written by the individual or organization may be included.

SUBMISSION FORMAT

Materials should be assembled in a binder, booklet, box, or folder. The format may be determined by the nominator, but the submission should not be larger than 11" x 17". Entries will be returned to applicants who are not selected for the award, but please do not send original materials.

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

The Professional Excellence Awards will be presented at the Holiday Party and Annual Meeting of AIA Chicago which will be held in early December 2010.
